Financial Tools and Incentives Subcommittee

Financial Tools and Incentives Subcommittee recommended action regarding.

Sheryl Caldwell presented the details for a 7c tax incentive.

• **Heidner Family Limited Partnership.** 2595 W. Golf LLC. The site well be developed into a newly constructed 6,200 sq. ft. five-unit strip mall shopping center with 29 parking stalls to be occupied by neighborhood type retail. This project is a second part of a previous development on the north side of the street of a 10,500 sq. ft. gas station, convenience store and car wash d/b/a Ricky Rockets Fuel Center and Car Wash that was presented an approved by EDAC in February of 2018. The applicant agreed to redeveloped the current site to revitalized the corners of Barrington Road and Golf Road.

Motion and second for approval. Erin Aleman abstained from the vote. The item was approved.

Art Williams presented the details for a 7b tax incentive.

• Shapra Group II, LLC,. Applicant seeks a Class 7b Property Tax incentive in order to develop the Avid by IHG, InterContinental Hotels Group branded hotel on a 1.7-acre parcel of vacant land that is part of a larger tract of farmland. The proposed hotel lot presents special challenges due to challenging topographic and soil conditions. Soil remediation, volume control conditions, and permeable pavement systems on the remainder of the property also present difficulties and substantial hidden construction cost and increased land development cost. All of these physical factors limit the utility of the property and burden its development and ongoing business operations with extraordinary cost.
