The Cook County Bureau of Economic Development presented the application for a Class 7c Property Tax Incentive submitted by CPMOK Properties. The Class 7c Eligibility is based on no purchase for value vacant for more than 12 months with substantial rehabilitation. BED staff supports the findings of the City of Chicago and concurs with their recommendation for a Class 7c Property Tax Incentive for the project site. This is a medical re-development located in the Beverly Neighborhood. 80% of the build out was completed December 2019 with a100% build out completed by 2020. There was a motion and second for approval. The item passed.

The Cook County Bureau of Economic Development presented the application for a Class 7c
Property Tax Incentive submitted by Recreational Equipment, Inc. (REI). The Class 7c
Eligibility is based on no purchase for value vacant for more than 12 months. REI, is an
American retail and outdoor recreation services corporation. It is organized as a consumers'
co-operative. REI sells sporting goods, camping gear, travel equipment, and clothing. It also
offers services such as outdoor-oriented vacations and courses. The property will be used for
commercial purposes. The village has resolution of support in April 2020. REI is consumer
cooperative owned by members. 75% of profit goes back to the members. Additionally, some
of the profit goes back to communities and the rest is kept for developing company. The item
passed.
