Each year, the JAC enters into numerous Professional Services and Professional Social Services Agreements with local human services providers. These contract opportunities include:

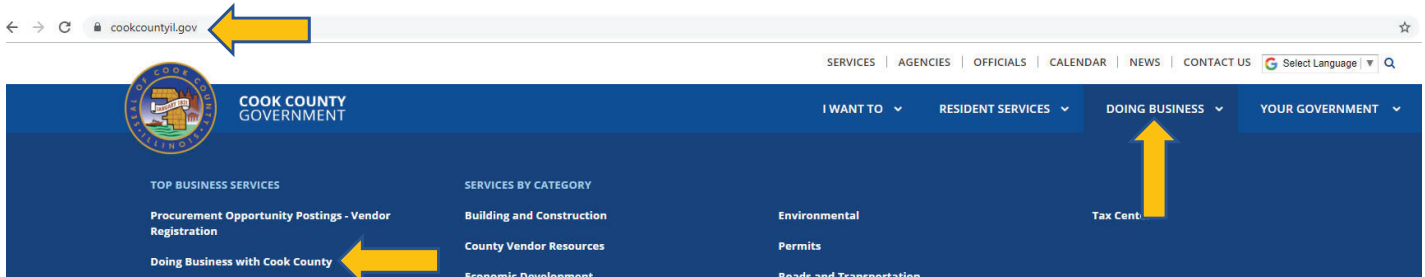

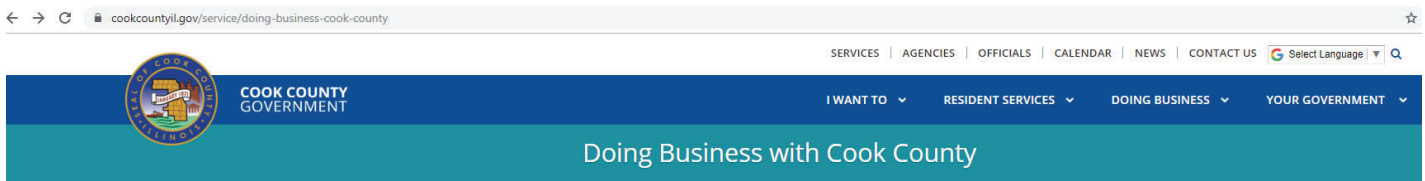
OPEN DATA-CONTRACT & AMENDMENT LIBRARY

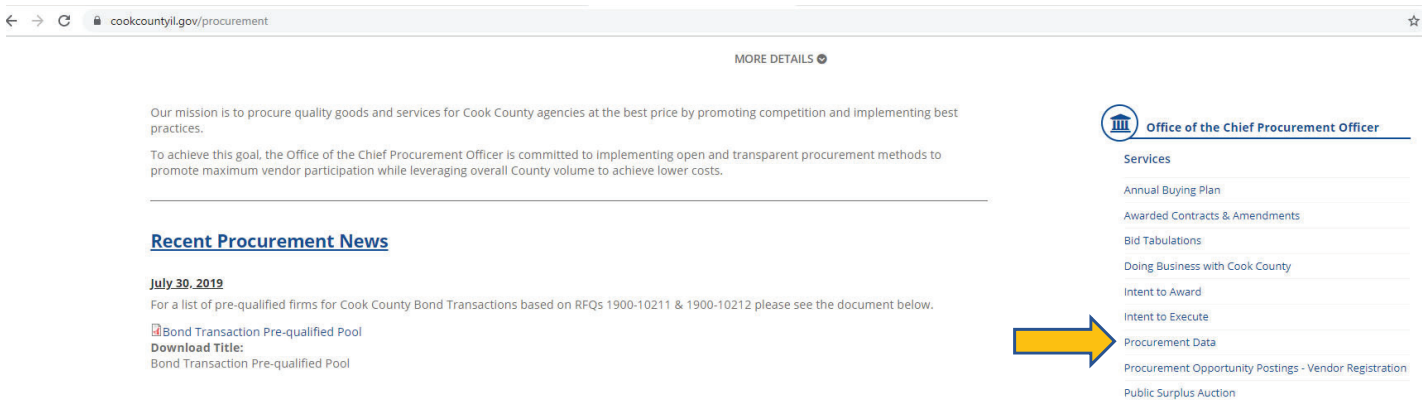

SOLICITATION DOWNLOAD LIST

On our solicitation or contract opportunities website called Bonfire, we offer what we call a download list (also referred to as document takers list) for each solicitation. This list displays in real time the names and contact information of each person and firm that has downloaded documents related to the solicitation. This information is valuable for several reasons:

- Potential M/WBE firms can use this information to contact potential prime vendors to partner with to meet the M/WBE goals on the solicitation.
- As a firm interested in a solicitation, you will be able to view all others who have downloaded the solicitation and are interested to see who your competition may be.

COOK COUNTY PROCUREMENT CODE

The Office of the Chief Procurement Officer (“OCPO”) as mandated by the Cook County Procurement Code, set forth in the Cook County Code of Ordinances, procures all goods, services, construction, equipment and supplies for Cook County (the “County”), with the exception of the Cook County Forest Preserve District (FPD), the Cook County Health & Hospitals System (CCHHS), Cook County Housing Authority (CCHA) and the Cook County Land Bank Authority (CCLBA).

Our Procurement Code improves the efficiency, enhances procurement process transparency, facilitates the implementation of best practices, maximizes value, and facilitates participation by MWBE certified firms.
