**Prepare to Bid** | Prepare, review, and finalize a bid or proposal. Locate technical information and pricing data. Prepare for pre-bid conferences, short-list interviews, debriefings and pre-award meetings.



**Contract Assistance** | Understand RFID, UID, and packaging standards. Participate in electronic and other Internet-based bid opportunities. Handle post-award contract administration.
