You are permitted to have union representation or legal counsel present while you are being questioned.

You have a duty as a government employee to answer all questions truthfully. If you refuse or fail to answer questions truthfully, you can be subject to discipline up to and including discharge.

Your answers and any information derived from them may be used against you in administrative disciplinary proceedings. However, your answers and any information or evidence derived from them cannot be used against you in any criminal proceedings.
