CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT – INTERVIEW

Section 2-285 of the Cook County Code provides: “It shall be the duty of all County employees, officials, agents, contractors, subcontractors, licensees, grantees or persons or businesses seeking County contracts, grants, licenses, or certification of eligibility for County contracts, to cooperate with the OIIG in the conduct of investigations undertaken pursuant to this division.” Therefore, you are advised of the following:

DO *NOT* DISCUSS YOUR INTERVIEW WITH OTHERS, INCLUDING YOUR COWORKERS, AS DOING SO MAY COMPROMISE THE INTEGRITY OF THIS INVESTIGATION. YOUR FAILURE TO COOPERATE IN THIS WAY MAY SUBJECT YOU TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR OTHER SANCTION UNDER THE INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR GENERAL’S ORDINANCE.

By signing this document, you acknowledge that you have been advised of the aforementioned obligations regarding confidentiality under the Independent Inspector General’s Ordinance. In addition, you agree not to disclose communications from the interview in which you participate (as an interviewee or representative) to others without prior authorization from the Independent Inspector General.
