DO *NOT* DISCUSS THE INVESTIGATION WITH ANYONE OUTSIDE THE OIIG, AS DOING SO MAY COMPROMISE THE INTEGRITY OF THIS INVESTIGATION. YOUR FAILURE TO COOPERATE IN THIS WAY MAY SUBJECT YOU TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR OTHER SANCTION UNDER THE INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR GENERAL'S ORDINANCE.

By signing this document, you acknowledge that you have been advised of the aforementioned obligations regarding confidentiality under the Independent Inspector General's Ordinance. In addition, you agree not to disclose any evidence or information obtained in this investigation to anyone outside the OIIG without prior written authorization from the Independent Inspector General.
