To request a Silver Star Service Banner for a wounded or ill service member or veteran, please type or print legibly and completely fill out the form. ONE (1) FREE 8.5" X 14" Service Banner per recipient. Veterans MUST reside within Cook County to participate in the June 6th, 2017 Silver Star Service Banner Ceremony, with this application completed and received by the office of Cook County Department of Veterans Affairs no later than May 16th, 2017.

Qualifications for the Silver Star Service Banner Program

Silver Star Families of America define a wounded service member as any Armed Forces personnel either currently serving honorably or those who have served honorably from ANY war, who having served in a war zone, has been wounded by enemy action or who have been injured or contracted a serious illness that could be rated at least 10 percent disabled by the Department of Veterans Affairs. All wounds, injuries or illnesses must have originated in a war zone, including: Purple Heart recipients, victims of friendly fire, injured in a war zone, and those who suffer from PTS, TBI, Agent Orange Effects and Gulf War Syndrome.
